History

- ◆Program was introduced to Louisiana in 1988.
- ◆Foundation of LBPA incorporated as 501(c)(4) organization.
- ◆Foundation trustees consist of 7 community members and 6 bowling proprietors.
- ◆Stuart Moss, proprietor of Metro Bowl was chosen to administer the program.

Participation & Scholarships

- ◆Youth bowlers from 15 Louisiana bowling centers currently participate in the program.
- ◆Over 1000 youth bowlers registered for the 2008-09 program.
- ◆Over \$835,000.00 has been raised for the scholarship fund as of February 1, 2009.
- ◆Over \$200,000.00 has been paid out to numerous colleges, universities, and other accredited schools throughout the country.
- ◆The Grand Prix Scholarship Program is now in over 20 states, so youth that are moving may be able to continue in the program.

Louisiana Youth Grand Prix Scholarship Singles Tournament

- ◆Annual tournament was started in 1996.
- ◆The 2009 tournament had 379 entries, representing 328 youth bowlers and their families.
- ◆\$5,100.00 in scholarships given to winners of the tournament.
- ◆\$1,003.00 in scholarships given to winners of the Dr Pepper Shootout.
- ◆\$912.00 given in Grand Prix points to all participants.
