Dear Graduating Senior or Continuing Graduate,

Congratulations on your recent high school graduation. I am very pleased that you participated in the great sport of bowling and the Grand Prix Scholarship Program.

The enclosed annual letter states the amount of money you have earned in the scholarship fund. This amount will be paid on your behalf to the college, university or trade school of your choice provided it is an accredited institution of higher education and learning as defined by the corresponding state's department of education. You must enroll within 18 months of your graduation and continuously thereafter until the complete scholarship is used. Funds will be paid directly to the institution for direct expenses of higher education. Only expenses that can be billed by the institution will be paid out. If you are not enrolled within 18 months, you may apply to the FLBPA office for an extension. If you are enrolled but do not need these funds at this time, you must annually submit proof of school enrollment until you are able to use the scholarship.

To use your Grand Prix funds, begin by submitting the "Request For Scholarship Funds" form to the state office. Then, bring the enclosed "To whom it may concern" letter to your institution when you pay your registration fees. They will bill the Foundation for an amount up to your total scholarship amount credited. If you have already paid your fees for this semester, send a copy of your tuition bill and certified receipt to the Foundation's office for a check to obtain reimbursement from your school.
