Solution Requirement

Evidence

Do not use all of scholarship when initially applied for.	Excess money will be paid out in that person's name continually until the funds are exhausted up to a maximum of 10 years.	Continued enrollment of at least 1 term per calendar year and evidence supplied to Foundation by each Jan. 31st.
Youth is not enrolled in school within 18 months.	May apply to Foundation for an extension before the 18 month deadline. Request must be a written letter and include reason for not yet entering school.	If extension is granted, subsequent request must be sent in by each Jan. 31st until youth is enrolled in school.
Student has enrolled in school, but cannot begin using their scholarship due to other scholarships.	If otherwise eligible, scholarship will be frozen upon written request to Foundation. Student must attend school at least 1 term per calendar year.	Written request to keep scholarship frozen must be sent in each Jan. 31st, if that student meets these requirements.
Student initially enrolled, but then drops out.	An additional 12 months is added to the original 18 month deadline.	Submit proof of enrollment before the 18 month deadline and before each subsequent Jan. 31st.
