Enclosed are the results of our 22nd Annual Grand Prix Youth Bowlers' Scratch Singles Tournament. The entries were up from last year and the competition was great. Special thanks to Angie Allen for all the tournament preparations, results and making this event happen. Thanks also go out to my onsite tournament staff, Rita Daigle, John and Renella Cormier, Gerald Vedros, Wendy Chapman, Mandi and Devin Legendre, Chris Floyd, Kay and Tony Savoie and Leroy Taylor Sr. I couldn't have made it without you. With the Dr. Pepper Shootout, the points total 6,968 which will convert to \$6,968.00 in the scholarship fund for this tournament.
