The average to be used will be determined in the following order:

- Highest yearbook average (Regular or Sport) from the 2020-21 USBC winter season, based on 12 games or more.
- If no 2020-21 yearbook average, then the highest 2021 USBC summer average (Regular or Sport), based on 12 games or more.
- If no 2020-21 yearbook, or summer average, the current average (Regular or Sport) of 12 games or more as of December Youth Director is responsible for reporting current averages 31, 2021 shall be
- Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements must bowl scratch.
- The tournament shall be handicap, based on 90% of 200

.0 Format / Participation

- The tournament shall consist of a four-person team event, doubles, and singles, with an optional scratch all-events
- Three games will be bowled in each event.
- A member may enter the team event twice. Not more than two members on a four member team can bowl together on a second team and place in
- bowled first, followed by singles. Scores bowled by an ineligible player will be disqualified. A member may enter the doubles & singles events once. If you enter doubles then you must enter singles and vice-versa. Doubles event will be
- Under no circumstance will you be allowed to bowl multiple teams on the same squad. When a member is bowling two teams, it will be the member's responsibility to schedule the team events so they are not bowled at the same time.
- Your highest team series and your doubles & singles scores will count towards your all events provided the fees for all events have been paid.

- 9 Bottoms - Male participants are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or clastic bottoms. Slacks shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts, or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing and their zipper and a button to be eligible. Jeans are not permitted. Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking loosely at their side. Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted. arms are hanging must have a
